The Naloxone Availability Score ranges from 0-100 and represents the level of availability of no-cost naloxone and of pharmacies that sell naloxone in each county.

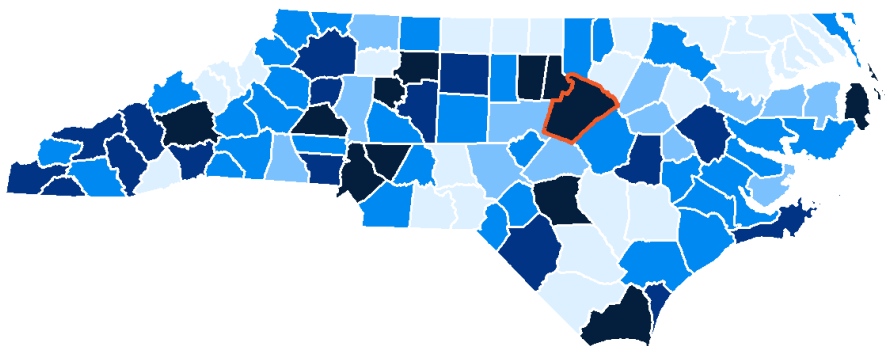
